

Tournament Rules:

1. Eligibility:

- 1. Any USBC Adult league bowling at a BPAC/GA member center and bowled 50 games or more between the dates of August 1, 2023 and May 31, 2024. Member must be in good standing at the center at the time of entry and competition.
- 2. USBC rules will be in effect.
- 3. Team/Entries: A center may buy multiple entries to the final event. Teams may enter multiple times as long as squads are available. Entries must originate from the member center and will not be taken directly at the final event.
- 4. Team will consist of 5 bowlers who meet the criteria. Teams will be mixed and must have at least one male and one female on the team.
- 5. Teams may come from multiple BPAC/GA centers as long as each bowler has a minimum of 50 games in their home center.
- 6. PBA MEMBERS are limited to no more than 1 per team.

2. Cost :

1. \$300 per team per entry. Purchased by the member center. Entry fee includes prize fund and lineage.

3. Averages:

- 1. Averages will be the bowlers highest average from ALL leagues bowled at any center for the past two seasons (min 21 games).
- 2. Handicap for this tournament will be 90% of 230.
- 3. Baker Handicap will be 20% of each bowler's handicap added together for a team handicap.

4. Championships:

- 1. Each entered team captain will be notified of squad times by the BPAC/GA tournament director.
- 2. All team member must report together as a team 30-minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
- 3. All teams will bowl three standard games on Saturday. Using those scores, the teams will be seeded for Baker match play on Sunday. Sunday will be a single elimination match play. The winner will be determined by the 3 game series with handicap.
- 4. Once a team begins the tournament, there will be no substitutes.
- 5. Absent bowlers will receive a zero.

5. Payout:

- 1. Prize checks will be made payable to the team captain. Team Captain is responsible for distributing funds. Checks will be available one week after tournament.
- 2. Prize ratio 1:6.
- 3. \$10,000 guaranteed first place.
- 4. All side pots will be run by the tournament committee and paid out upon squad completion.

6. Uncovered Rules:

- 1. Lanes will be redressed between squads on Saturday, and will be dressed before the start of competition on Sunday.
- 2. Any rules not covered by these definitions will be decided by the tournament director.

Local Qualifying Tournament Rules:

1. Eligibility:

- 1. Any USBC Adult league bowling at a (<u>BPAC/GA member center</u>) and bowled 50 games or more between the dates of August 1, 2023 and May 31, 2024. Member must be in good standing at the center at the time of entry and competition.
- 2. USBC rules will be in effect.
- 3. Team/Entries: A team may enter as many times as squads are available.
- 4. Team will consist of 5 bowlers who meet the criteria. Teams will be mixed and must have at least one male and one female on the team.

2. Cost:

1. (\$50) per team per entry. Entry fee includes prize fund and lineage.

3. Averages:

- 1. Averages will be the bowlers highest average from ALL leagues bowled at any center for the past two seasons.
- 2. Handicap for this tournament will be 90% of 230.
- 3. Baker Handicap will be 20% of each bowler's handicap added together for a team handicap.

4. Championships:

- 1. Each entered team captain will be notified of squad times by the BPAC/GA tournament director.
- 2. All team member must report together as a team 30-minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
- 3. All teams will bowl three standard games followed by four baker games. Total pinfall plus handicap determines the winner.
- 4. Once a team begins the tournament, there will be no substitutes.
- 5. Absent bowlers will receive a zero.

5. Payout:

- 1. Will be announced prior to the start of the tournament. Winners will receive a paid entry into the BPAC/GA finals to take place at Myrtle Beach Bowl, on Oct 26-27, 2024.
- 2. At the association finals the payout will be
 - 1. Prize checks will be made payable to the team captain. Team Captain is responsible for distributing funds. Checks will be available one week after tournament.
 - 2. Prize ratio 1:6.
 - 3. \$10,000 guaranteed first place.
- 3. All side pots will be run by the tournament committee and paid out upon squad completion.

6. Uncovered Rules:

- 1. Center may set up multiple qualifiers and buy unlimited number of entries.
- 2. Any rules not covered by these definitions will be decided by the tournament director.
